LISTEN FURTHER

Jesus blessed many without care for himself. He walked with sinners. He gave Joy and hope to all around him. Yet they HATED HIM.

When he cried out for love...
they HATED and IGNORED him.

As he carried the crown of thorns upon his head, blood in his eyes. The pain of the leather lashes, stripes on his back. Pain all through him,

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yet he wondered if all of it was done.
Yet they HATED him and they IGNORED him.

HE WAS ALONE...

All alone, no one to take up his cause, he laid his
back on the cold merciless wood of the cross knowing
full well what would come next.
Yet they HATED him and they IGNORED him.
HE WAS ALONE...

Alone looking up, on his back on the cross, blood in his eyes.
Did he gaze to the right as the hammer struck the spike through
his flesh, bonding his flesh to the wood as one. Searing pain
burning him through. Did he have time to wonder why?

Did he ask himself "Did I not love them?"
Did he ask himself "What have I done to deserve this?"

Again the hammer struck, horror blind in pain and terror
the faces of those around him looking on him with HATE
and he was completely ALONE.

Again the hammer struck, his bondage complete wood bound
to metal, so hung his flesh. Completely alone and without
anyone to help him. No peace, no hope of rest.
Yet they HATED him and they TAUNTED him.
HE WAS ALONE...

Is this where you are? Do you realize that Jesus is not alone, that even in his despair as in your
despair He had someone with Him, someone in His mind, someone that even through the pain
and agony and abandonment wrecked Him, He had with him even in His heart? Even as God
the Father had sent Him and seemingly forsook Him. Jesus had someone. Someone precious,
special someone He needed, someone who made it all worth the sacrifice. He had a purpose
most of all . . .

He had you.

Will you yet abandon him too?

Can you imagine this? Maybe you can, maybe you are in a same place.

Finally a Mocking laughter as they posted the placard
"King of the Jews".

How alone did he feel? He felt alone to the point of shouting
"Father why hast thou forsaken me?" Forgotten by God, what a terrible fate.

Yet in your pain and suffering right now you were with Him comforting Him. You gave Him hope and peace in what He was going through. Even as messed up as you see yourself and how folks have abandoned you, you were there for Jesus as He was abandoned by everyone else. There you were alone with Him bringing Him peace in the hell that was His separation from everything He knew. He had you. How valuable you must be to have helped the King of Kings face His desperation of loneliness, His torture by man, His abuse that cut physically and mentally. You are so precious to Him because as all others abandoned Him you remained and you are there with Him, comforting Him, just by being here now. He had a purpose . . . you.

Do you know why he suffered this fate?

Do you feel hated?

So does He.

Do you feel Alone?

So does He.

Do you feel real pain?

So does He.

Do you feel despair?

So does He.

So what's the difference you ask? After all He died, right.

So maybe I should die too.

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Who will comfort Him if you die? Who will understand what the pain was He faced? Who will be His faithful witness understanding His pain, telling people of it with understanding and truth because you know it; just you alone with Him when all others abandoned Him.

Why do you stay? Why must you live? Because you alone understand what He went through.

Think, if you die now who do you die for? Who will you hurt?
What is the reward?

Jesus died and suffered for one reason alone...
BECAUSE HE LOVES YOU!!

You were there for Him as He faced it alone, He is here with you now because you were there for Him, in your pain and desperation, you were there. He felt PAIN, ANGUISH, DESPAIR and was HATED for All of us, yet only a few of us can understand what it was He went through. You understand that, I am sure. You understand that from where you stand. Know that He had a purpose, that you were with Him as he faced His just as He is now with you as you face yours. His purpose is. . . you. You little one, you the precious child, hang on, He is there. He valued the comfort you brought Him as he faced his pain. Know it is His desire to also comfort you. It is for you He suffered. You His purpose gave Him comfort.

He loved you so much he gave His life for you, so you may live. Just because He wanted to show you His thankfulness for being there when the entire world turned away, not so you could die of the same things, but because He set you free of them.

As He suffered all those horrible things you were there for Him. You were a comfort, a purpose. He has not forgotten you your pain. He will come to you and be with you to comfort you, just as you once comforted Him.

He chose and allowed Himself to suffer those things through no action of His own for you. So that now in your suffering and despair He can be with you as you were with Him. Call upon Him in honest raw truth.

Your real, honest, understanding of where He was, comforted Him in His purpose, so that while you were there for Him He can be here for you now, immediately this second. He had a purpose. . . you.

You see of all the things in the world, the One that truly understands how you feel had the comfort of you with Him when He suffered. Your pain is real, your depression is real, your anguish is real, so was His.

Yet while He suffered there you were. Now here you are suffering and now you need to know that He is here with you. Cry out to Him in raw honesty, He won't be offended, He understands the pain and anguish of a tortured body and mind; He understands the torture of despair and abandonment. You have something in common with the God of Gods, your pain. Jesus gave Himself so that when you have pain He can help you walk through it, because you are and were there for each other.

When He suffered, He did so because He valued your company and valued your heart and valued your innocence that was destroyed by man. Yet Jesus values it and cherishes you even when man has tried to destroy you. Jesus knows you understand His suffering at the cross, and now He is here with you to comfort you. Just as you were there for Him as you suffered at the hands of men.

The difference is Jesus can ease your pain, fill your empty places, hold you while you weep. You are never alone because when Jesus gave His life for all men and women you were there. You have value to the King, value to the one who suffered and was crushed by the hatred and vile corruption of men.

Reach to Him, cry out to him yet again. Just ask Him, ask Him now. To ask is easy and what have you to lose?

No special requirements, no special speeches, just ask. He loves you. Just ask Him to help you, to hold you, to take you in his arms. Then be still. Be still and let him work. Be still and feel Him all around you. Take a breath. Breathe. . .

In Jesus name so Glory can come to him through you to "Just ask Him"
YOU ARE NOT ALONE

Jesus help me.

You are never alone. When you are suffering the worst that you have ever suffered, you are with Him comforting Him as He suffered on the cross so that now He can help you. Turn to Him. He had a purpose. . . you.
